2020 Prison Elimination Act (PREA) Corrective Action Plan

Central Texas Treatment Center has adopted a zero-tolerance policy regarding sexual abuse and sexual harassment and is continuously improving policies and procedure in order to prevent, detect and respond to sexual victimization.

In 2019 the department continued its' efforts regarding PREA by focusing on improving current policies and procedures. Central Texas Treatment Center continued to enhance safety and security through the installation of additional video monitoring technology. Memorandum of Agreements (MOU) with local rape crisis centers were executed along with the regularly scheduled PREA Education Class for the residents.

During 2020 calendar year Central Texas Treatment Center had a total of 3 PREA Allegations. Below you will find the 2019/2020 comparison table breaking down the details of the allegations.

Central Texas Treatment Center continues to provide extensive training for both residents and staff to ensure a safe environment to participate in treatment.

Based upon a review of the above allegation as well as findings from the PREA Audit, Central Texas Treatment Center recommends no corrective actions at this time. We will, however, continue to monitor staffing patterns including additional staff training when allegations occur against staff, residents' relationships with each other and with staff, and video monitoring of the facility.
